Our hedges have a reputation for transplanting seamlessly no matter the season in which they are planted.

How do we do it?



Step 1 – Start Small

We start all of our own hedges in house either from seed or cuttings. This ensures purity, cleanliness, and consistency from the very beginning. The hedges are planted out using GPS technology when they are just a few inches tall in their final spacing – 10” for the field grown hedges.

Step 2 – Root Prune

With a series of blades that gradually increase in size, we begin yearly root pruning. This ensures that by harvest time, every inch of hedge has a thriving, fibrous root system that will withstand transplant shock.



Step 3 – Prune Shoots

Each crop is pruned yearly (or more, depending on the variety) to maintain beautifully dense and consistent branching. All field crops are pruned to a 14” thickness to ensure that sunlight can reach all the way to the lower branches for optimum health and vigor.



Step 4 – Dig to Order

Our incredible harvesting process combined with the root pruning allows us to dig any time of year so the hedges are as fresh as possible going into your installation. Our system minimizes stress on the roots, giving your hedge the best possible start.

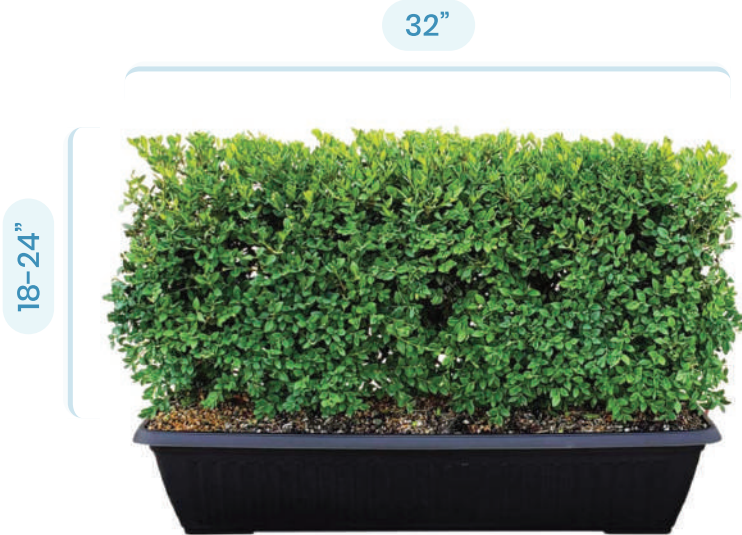

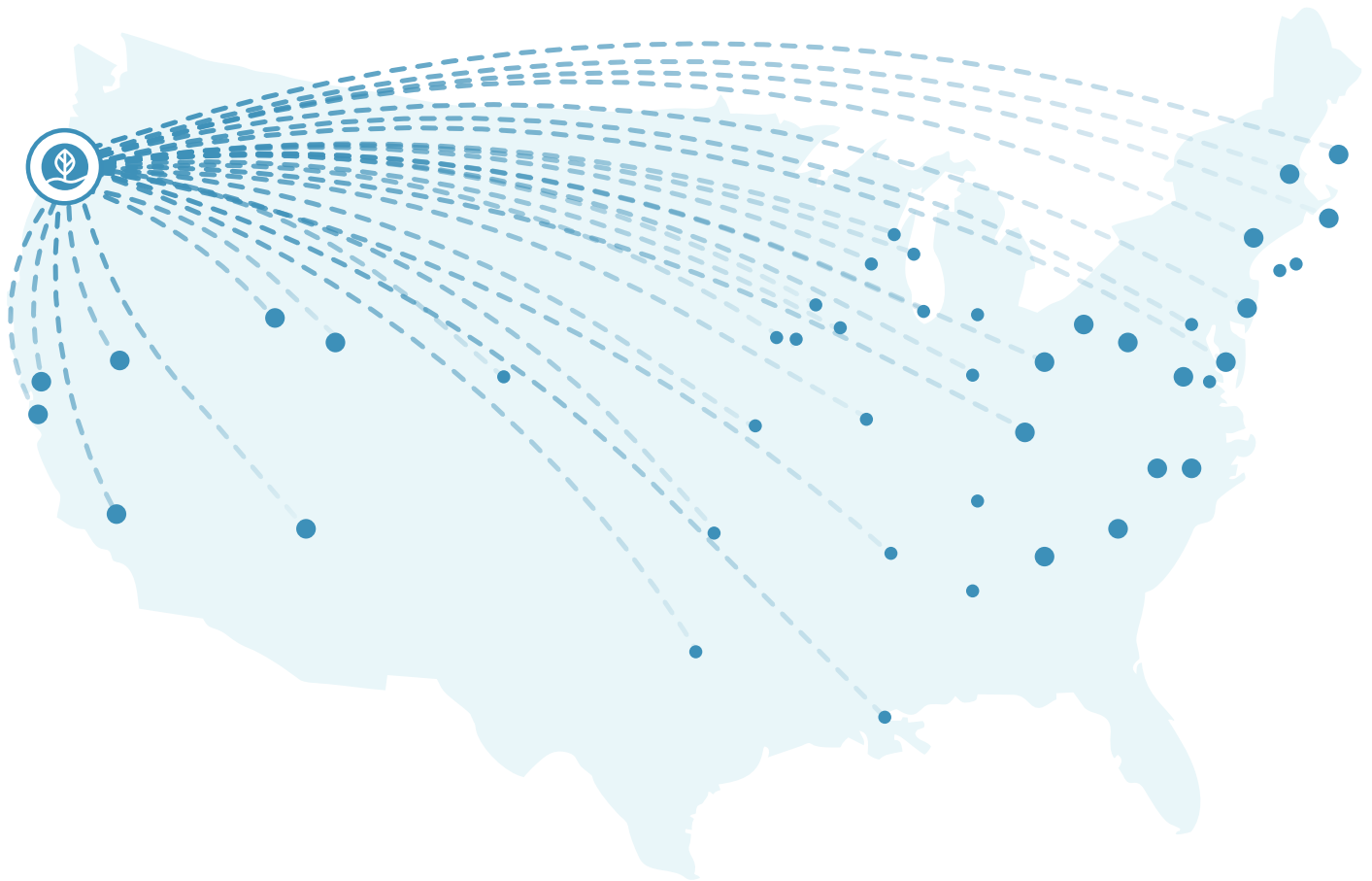

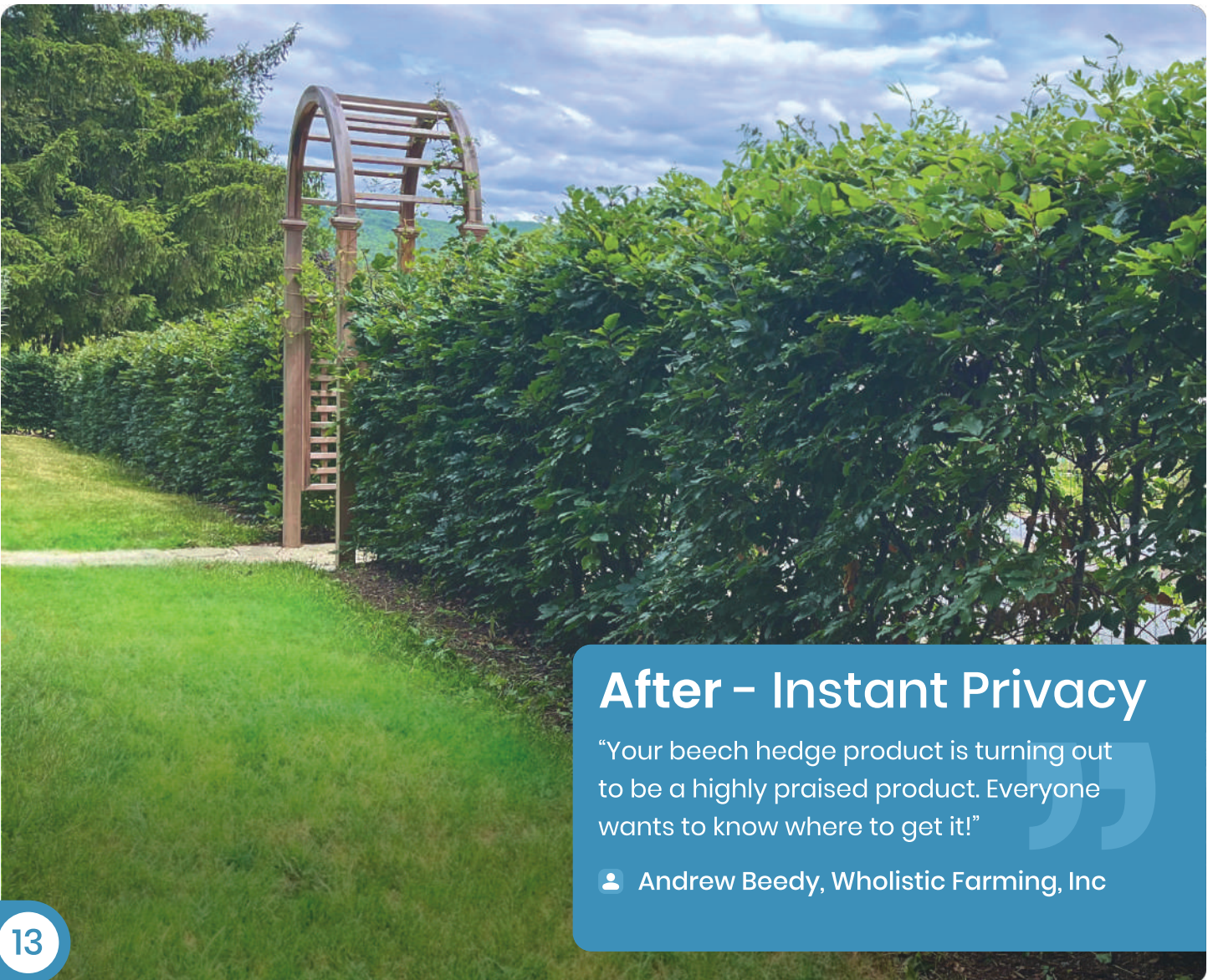
